\& lt;p\& gt;The firstborn son of S\& \#233;rgio B uarque de Hollanda, B uarque lived at several locations throughout his childhood, though mostly in Rio de J aneiro, S\& \# 227;0 Paulo, and Rome. He wrote and studied literature as a child and found musi c through the bossa nova compositions of Tom Jobim and Jo\& \#227;0 Gilberto. He pe rformed as a singer and guitarist in the 1960 s as well as writing a play that wa s deemed dangerous by the B razilian military dictatorship of the time. Buarque, along with several Tropicalist and M PB musicians, was threatened by the Brazilia n military government and eventually left Brazil for Italy in 1969. However, he came back to B razil in 1970, and continued to record, perform, and write, though much of his material was suppressed by government censors. He released several more albums in the 1980s and published three novels in the 1990s and 2000s.\& 1 t ;/ p\>
