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There are 9 squares involved with the 7, so 480 9=471 other squares. These other squares contain the 92 other mines. So the number of grids with a 7 at a particular spot is 8(47192). That is out of a total of (48) Tj T* BT /F1

We have 492556=125244 ways for an easy grid to have an 8 somewhere. Out of the 1.88 trillion total easy grids, this gives a probability of about 610 8. So, very rare indeed!
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
